LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Kristy Ambat by her attorneys, Hampson and Company, Apollo House East, 4th Floor, 87 Mary Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff seeks the following relief:

1. An order pursuant to s.3 of the Act for partition of that parcel of land described as South Sound Block 7C Parcel 96 H2 ("the Parcel") as between the Plaintiff and the Defendant, reflecting their registered interests as proprietors of the Parcel.
2. In the alternative to the foregoing an order pursuant to s.4 and s.5 of the Act directing the sale of the Parcel, including consequential directions as to valuation etc., and division of the proceeds of sale between the Plaintiff and the Defendant.
3. Further or in the alternative, that the Defendant be ordered to pay to the Plaintiff such sum as the Court deems appropriate by way of occupation rent.
4. Interest on all sums due and owing.

5. The costs of this application including pursuant to s.17 of Act, and such further and other relief as to this Honourable Court may seem just.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1106.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.

4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
