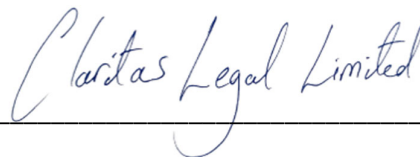

BY THIS ORIGINATING SUMMONS, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff Mrs Chandni Roy of Flat 14, 17 Clarges Street, London W1J 8AE, the Plaintiff claims against the First Defendant (in its capacity as trustee of a settlement dated 20 February 2026 and personally) and the Second Defendant and seeks the following relief:

1. A declaration that 50,000 fully-paid ordinary shares of nominal or par value of USD1 each in the Second Defendant (the **"Shares"**) now standing in the name of the First Defendant are held by the First Defendant on trust for the Plaintiff absolutely;
2. An Order that the First Defendant transfer the Shares to the Plaintiff or as she shall direct;
3. An Order that the register of members of the Second Defendant be updated accordingly;
4. Should it be necessary, an account and inquiry into the First Defendant's dealings with the Shares;
5. Such further or other relief as is just;
6. Costs.

If any Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to it as the Court may think just and expedient.
