THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

WITHIN 14 DAYS after service of this Complaint on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying *Acknowledgment of Service* form stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out **full particulars of your defence** in the space provided in the *Acknowledgment of Service* form.

IF YOU FAIL to satisfy the claim or fail to return the *Acknowledgment of Service* form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for a **default judgment** without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is an individual resident in the Cayman Islands.
2. The Defendant is a Cayman Islands company carrying on business from Unit A1, 45 Blue Lagoon Drive, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. On or about 24 August 2024 the Plaintiff and the Defendant entered into an agreement whereby the Defendant agreed to restore the Plaintiff's 1970 Chevrolet Camaro pursuant to Estimate No. 1256 and related communications.
4. Pursuant to that agreement, on 24 August 2024 the Plaintiff paid the Defendant the sum of US\$52,050.00.
5. The said payment comprised sums advanced in respect of parts and labour for the restoration project, together with additional funds paid to the Defendant to be held on account pending completion of the project.
6. The restoration project did not proceed as originally agreed between the parties.
7. On or about 20 November 2025, the Defendant, acting by its principal Larry McGean, agreed that the Plaintiff was entitled to reimbursement in the sum of US\$16,500.00.
8. The Defendant further agreed that:
 - a. US\$12,000.00 would be paid immediately; and
 - b. the remaining US\$4,500.00 would be paid by the end of January 2026.
9. Despite the said agreement and repeated requests for payment, the Defendant has failed and/or refused to pay the agreed sum of US\$16,500.00 or any part thereof.
10. The sum of US\$16,500.00 is therefore due and owing by the Defendant to the Plaintiff.
11. By letter dated 5 May 2026 the Plaintiff's attorneys made formal demand for payment of the said debt. The Defendant has failed to satisfy that demand.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

- a) The said sum of US\$16,500.00 as monies due and owing.
- b) Fixed costs in the sum of CI\$150.00 plus filing fees and bailiff's fee for service.

- c) Interest on US\$16,500 from 31 January 2026 until judgment pursuant to section 34 of the Judicature Act or at such rate as the Court deems appropriate

If within the time for returning Acknowledgement of Service the Defendants pay to the Plaintiff Attorneys-at-Law the total amount claimed of US\$16,500 (together with interest in the sum of US\$168.56 and costs of CI\$150.00) all further proceedings will be stayed.
