By this Originating Summons, the Plaintiff seeks the following directions, orders and relief pursuant to Section 11A of the Grand Court Act (As Revised) and/or the inherent jurisdiction of the Court, namely:

1 In aid of the debt enforcement proceedings commenced by the Plaintiff in the Pudong New Area People's Court of Shanghai in the People's Republic of China action number (2026) Hu 0115 Min Chu No. 39385. (the "**PRC Proceedings**"), the Respondents must not, pending determination of the PRC Proceedings, whether directly or indirectly through his servant or agents or any of them or otherwise howsoever:

- 1.1 must not remove from the Cayman Islands any of their assets which are in the Cayman Islands;
- 1.2 must not in any way dispose of, deal with or diminish the value of any of their assets whether they are in or outside the Cayman Islands; or
- 1.3 transfer or re-domicile themselves out of the Cayman Islands.

save that if the total unencumbered value of the Respondent's assets in the Cayman Islands exceeds RMB 21,610,088.30 (approximately, US\$3,169,448), the Respondent may remove from the Cayman Islands and may dispose of, deal with or diminish the value of such part of the Respondent's assets as exceeds that amount, so long as the total unencumbered value of the Respondent's assets remaining in the Cayman Islands continues to exceed RMB 21,610,088.30 (approximately, US\$3,169,448).

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2 For the avoidance of doubt, this prohibition includes the following assets:

2.1 any money, currency, coin, right or otherwise standing to the credit of any bank, exchange, trading, or online platform account including the amount of any cheque drawn on such account which has not been cleared, including:

(a) the First Respondent's cryptocurrency account with the cryptocurrency exchanges:

(i) "Binance" (User ID: 362024442);

(ii) "OKX" (User ID: 25416156282843136); and

(iii) "Gate.io" (User ID: 9123501);

(b) the Second Respondent's account with the cryptocurrency exchange "Binance" (with deposit address of 0x0CCA1A652d40d1ec1529bc6F77f4cCb33591C66b).

3 The Respondents must:

3.1 by 4.30pm on the seventh calendar day after service of this order and to the best of their ability inform the Plaintiff's attorneys of all their assets worldwide exceeding US\$1,000 in value whether in their own name or not and whether solely or jointly owned, giving the value, location and details of all such assets.

3.2 must swear and serve on the Applicant's attorneys an affidavit setting out the above information within 14 days after being served with this order.

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4 The Respondents shall pay the Plaintiff's the costs of these proceedings.

5 Such further or alternative order as the Court sees fit.

If you do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to you as the Court may think just and expedient.

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to the Defendant.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from the Defendant's own, the form must be completed by the Defendant with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after that Partner's name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN THAT PERSON'S OWN, the form must be completed by the Defendant with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after that Defendant's name.
