SUMMONS FOR DIRECTIONS

LET THE PARTIES attend before the Honourable in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on at upon an application by the Petitioners for the following orders:

1. Mr Joseph Chow (**Mr Chow**), be joined to the proceeding as Respondent.
2. The proceeding shall be treated as a proceeding between the Petitioners and Mr Chow.
3. TB Executives Unity Holding Limited (the **Company**) should be treated merely as the subject matter in the proceedings and shall only participate in the proceedings for the purposes of giving discovery if so directed by the Court.
4. The Petitioners be granted permission to serve the Petition herein, together with this Summons for Directions, the verifying affirmation and all supporting documents (together, the **Petition Documents**) on Mr Chow out of the jurisdiction of the Cayman Islands at 555 5th Avenue NE, Suite 1033, Saint Petersburg, Florida 33701, United States of America.

5. Service of the Petition Documents on Mr Chow may be effected by personal service in the first instance and failing this, registered post, and such service shall be deemed good and sufficient service of the Petition Documents on Mr Chow.
6. The Petition shall not be advertised.
7. If so advised, the Petitioner shall serve any further particulars of claim within seven days from the date of this order, otherwise, the Petition shall stand as the Petitioner's Particulars of Claim.
8. Mr Chow shall serve his Defence to the Petition within 28 days of service of the Petition Documents.
9. If so advised, the Petitioner shall file a reply within 21 days from the service of Mr Chow's Defence.
10. The parties shall exchange Lists of Documents within 28 days from service of the Defence or the Petitioner's Reply, whichever is later.
11. The parties shall provide inspection of documents within 14 days from exchange of Lists of Documents of copies of any documents referred to therein.
12. Any factual evidence to be relied on shall be given by affidavit or affirmation, with such evidence to be exchanged within 28 days after the expiry of the time for service of the Reply, if any.
13. The parties shall file any evidence in response, if so advised, by 14 days of the exchange of the factual evidence.
14. The deponents shall attend the hearing of the Petition for cross examination if notice is given 14 days before that their attendance is required.
15. The Petition shall be listed for hearing on a date to be fixed, with a time estimate to be confirmed and agreed by the parties or determined by the Court.

16. The Parties shall exchange and file skeleton arguments, and the Petitioner shall file and serve the hearing bundle by 4pm on the day that is 4 days prior to the hearing of the Petition.
17. Liberty to apply.
18. The costs of and incidental to this summons be costs in the Petition.
19. Such further or other directions as the Court sees fit.
