UPON the ex parte summons for directions filed on 2 July 2025 by the Petitioner seeking directions for the hearing of the petition herein

AND UPON reading the Petition herein filed on 2 July 2025 and the Affirmation of Ma Fei and exhibits MF-1 to MF-8 affirmed on 30 June 2025

AND UPON reading the Petitioner's written submissions dated 16 July 2025

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the proposed capital reduction does not involve either a diminution of liability in respect of unpaid share capital or the payment to any shareholder of any paid-up capital and that the requirement in section 15(2) of the Companies Act to settle a list of creditors is therefore not engaged

AND UPON the Court considering the summons for directions suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

1. The petition shall be listed for hearing before a Judge of the Grand Court at 9:30 am on 19 September 2025, when any creditor or shareholder of the Petitioner who desires to object may attend and be heard.
2. The Petitioner shall cause notice of the presentation of the petition and of the day fixed for the hearing of the petition to be inserted once in the Cayman Gazette and twice in The Standard Hong
