By this Summons, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff, as Executor of the Estate, c/o KSG Attorneys at Law, 4th Floor One Capital Place, Shedden Road, George Town, Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff seeks the following relief of the Court:

1. A declaration that Article III of the Deceased's Will dated 19 June 2018 (the "**Deceased's Will**"), insofar as it concerns the provision of a suitable house for Shanti Persad, is void for uncertainty.
2. In the alternative to the foregoing, a declaration as to the true construction of Article III of the Deceased's Will concerning the provision of a suitable house for Shanti Persad,

3. Such other relief as the Court finds just.

**Notes for Guidance**

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
