ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION OF AA and BB by Originating Summons dated 26 May 2026 (the
"Application")

AND UPON reading of the evidence of the Applicants and the Respondent, and the exhibits
thereto

AND UPON reading the written submissions of the Applicants in relation to the Application

AND UPON reading the letter dated 28 May 2026 from Carey Olsen Cayman Limited the attorneys for the Applicants and noting the request for the Application to be dealt with administratively without the need for an oral hearing

AND UPON the Court considering the Application to be suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DIRECTED that:-

1. Pursuant to the Court's exercise of its powers under section 10(1) of the Trusts Act (as revised) and/or its inherent jurisdiction the First Applicant is appointed as the sole trustee of the A Trust in place of all other trustees (if any) of the A Trust.
2. The assets of the Trust are vested solely in the First Applicant in its capacity as trustee of the A Trust.
3. The First Applicant shall be at liberty to administer the assets of the Trust on the basis that it had been validly appointed as trustee of the A Trust by the deed dated 18 February 2013 (and all other trustees of the Trust had been discharged).

Representation

4. Pursuant to Grand Court Rules (2023 Revision) Order 15, Rules 12 and 13 the First Respondent is appointed as representative of the beneficiaries of the Trust and their minor or unborn children who are or may become beneficially interested under the trusts, powers or provisions of the Trust on the basis that:
 - 4.1 their interests are aligned; and
 - 4.2 it is expedient to do so for the purpose of saving expense.

Costs

5. Consequential to paragraph 1, the First Applicant shall be at liberty to raise and pay the costs of and occasioned by the Application of all parties from the Trust fund of the A Trust without prejudice to the ultimate incidence of costs (insofar as may be necessary to preserve claims against third parties in relation to the appointment dated 18 February 2013 but not otherwise) which shall be reserved to this Court.

Other Relief

6. The parties shall be at liberty to apply for further relief.
